In addition, we have the need for a database system which will allow us to more easily track our students' progress. As you can imagine, doing this manually for 3,500+ students is quite time-consuming. Do you or someone you know have the resources to help us set up and maintain our technological needs?

VOLUNTEERS

Our part-time CAA team is stretched to capacity by trying to fulfill all the requests and administrative needs of this ministry. We need volunteers (especially those fluent in Spanish) to meet the ever-increasing demand for mailing exams, grading exams and copying the daily radio programs on CDs. Another dream is to have volunteers help us send our imprisoned students cards and notes of encouragement throughout the year and during major holidays as well. If you are not a Spanish speaker, we would be happy to send you Bible verses in Spanish that you could copy to mail to the students. Would you consider being a volunteer for CAA?

FINANCIAL

CAA provides scholarships for all prisoners, all students from Cuba and any others who are unable to pay. The cost of putting one student through all 22 books is approximately \$300 or more depending on postage.

In addition, we need to reprint several of our course materials. Each reprint costs CAA approximately \$5,000. We would like to add two new courses to the curriculum as well. Will you get in touch with us if the Lord is leading you to contribute financially?

AN EXCITING BIBLE STUDY MINISTRY...

The Christian Academy of the Air, (CAA) is a non-profit, all Spanish, Bible teaching ministry aimed at helping future leaders of the Christian church learn about God's word and the Christian life through in-depth study. A division of the World Radio Network, the CAA was originally designed to bring Bible and theological courses to Spanish speaking pastors and church members who were unable to attend seminary. Today, the ministry has evolved to encompass a daily radio program and a correspondence school.



RADIO PROGRAMS

Students in different parts of the world can hear the daily 15-minute radio program. Currently there are over 750 programs that can be heard over approximately 40 radio stations.

CORRESPONDENCE COURSES

There are a total of 22 correspondence courses that CAA students can take. The courses are comprised of three levels: Basic, Intermediate and Advanced.

The Basic courses cover the gospel of John and the book of Acts. The Intermediate course is an overview of the Bible. The Advanced course materials are on an institute/seminary level. There are 19 textbooks including Introduction to Old and New Testaments, Christian Ethics, Biblical Geography and many more.

With each of the three levels, students complete the course at their own pace and send the exams to CAA headquarters. The exams are graded and the results are sent back to the students.

"Please excuse me that I received low grades, but I have decided to study all night when it is quiet and I can concentrate. The space is small and in the day there is so much noise. I am pushing myself to get better grades and for when I preach here in prison."

OUR STUDENTS...

Although it is difficult to estimate how many thousands of people are touched through the daily radio programs, we currently have approximately 3,500 students in the correspondence school which is growing steadily.

Our students are men and women, teens and elders, the imprisoned and the free. What they all have in common is a burning desire to study to prepare themselves to serve the Lord Jesus Christ. In the United States and Mexico, a large group of CAA students are imprisoned. The ministry receives letters daily from both male and female prisoners who share how they have grown in the knowledge of the Lord, and how this ministry has brought them hope and encouragement as they struggle through prison life. Around the world, our students come from over 21 countries, some of which are listed below.
